HARROW & HOPE

Buckinghamshire - England

Background

Henry & Kaye Laithwaite of Harrow & Hope make single-vineyard, grower sparkling wine at their estate in Marlow, England. They stand out from the other English sparkling producers in our book because of their location and much smaller size. Marlow is in Buckinghamshire, a county within the Thames Valley, about an hour northwest of London. There are very few wineries up there; most are located down in Sussex, Kent, or Surrey. Harrow & Hope will hit the nail on the head for curious sparkling wine buffs, particularly in the context of Champagne's ever-decreasing affordability. English sparkling wine is already in a very niche category of its own; add a small grower from the virtually unknown region of Buckinghamshire into the mix, and now you have something really special. Eric Asimov underscores what distinguishes Harrow & Hope from the rest. This "do-it-yourself, small-production setup," he writes, "is as different from the big English names as Champagne's growerproducers are from the big houses."

Highlights

Harrow & Hope makes single-vineyard, grower sparkling wine in an uncommon wine region: Buckinghamshire, England.

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The wines are made with the classic three varieties & are planted on flint rock and clay soils overlying chalk in the Thames Valley.
