

HEIRLOOM VINEYARDS

Heirloom Vineyards was conceived in vintage 2000, when a young winemaking student (Elena) caught the eye of a silly old wine judge (Zar). A love story ensued inspired by two vows: to preserve the best of unique old vineyards, and to champion the best clones of each variety planted in the most appropriate sites. Seven long vintages of trial and error passed before Heirloom Vineyards could make a wine that was fine enough to pass on to future generations. Today, the lone 'The Velvet Fog' Pinot Noir in this lineup comes from Elena & Zar's best Adelaide Hills vineyards in Kersbrook and Macclesfield, which embody the very best of cuttingedge-meets-old-school viticulture and winemaking. In a nutshell, that looks like hand picking and sorting, native yeast fermentations, basket pressing, and aging in old French oak barrels. Alongside Elena's other wine projects, Dandelion Vineyards and Sister's Run, Heirloom represents incredible value for time-honored styles of wines from South


