



# SMALL GULLY

Barossa Valley - Australia

## Background

Small Gully produces Shiraz of a distinctive, bold, and intense Barossa style with great expression of fruit character, reflecting the region and meticulous vineyard management. In 1998, winemaker Stephen Black teamed up with vigneron Darren Zimmerman and Robert Bader to establish Small Gully Wines on Roennfeldt Road, Marananga. Initially focused on small batches of high-quality wines, their production has grown to meet increasing demand. As Stephen traveled to promote their wines, his sons Joseph and Charlie took over operations, adhering to his detailed recipes and rituals. Joe, with an oenology degree from Adelaide University and experience at several wineries, returned to Small Gully in 2006. Charlie, with a background in viticulture and vineyard management, joined in 2011. Their combined expertise, along with Stephen's guidance, has added layers of complexity and excitement to Small Gully's wines. In a nutshell, the Small Gully wines can be thought of as traditional Barossa Valley Shiraz made with intention at an approachable price point.

## Highlights

- 1 Small Gully produces Shiraz of a distinctive, bold, and intense Barossa style with great expression of fruit character.
- 2 Winemaker Stephen Black is also the de facto winemaker for Shinas Estate in Victoria, another project known for its bold Shirazes.

## Wines



### 'Little Book' Shiraz SRP \$20

The 'Little Book' comes from the Marananga Vineyards in the Barossa Valley. Aged 3 years in 300L French and American oak for a rich flavor profile. 15.5% ABV.



### 'The Formula' Shiraz SRP \$20

This one is mostly from Robert's Vineyard in the Adelaide Plains. Vines range from 50-58-years-old, making this a serious bottle for a steal. Aged 2 years in hogsheads. 15.8% ABV.
