Rocking Horse is a layered, complex, barrel-aged white, and Wanderer's Heart is a Syrah-dominant, partial-whole cluster red blend. Amazing value!

Thorne and Daughters Wines, founded in 2012 by John and Tasha Seccombe in the Western Cape, is known for producing some of South Africa's best white wines. "Raising our handcrafted wines along with our two daughters," is their motto, and it underscores their slow and steady commitment to perfecting their craft and premiumizing the category. It also nods to their choice to name their wines after children's toys. John is a master blender, evidenced by his white Rocking Horse and red Wanderer's Heart blends, two of South Africa's best values on the market today. The wines in his single-vineyard, varietal range ('Snakes & Ladders' Sauvignon Blanc, 'Cat's Cradle' Chenin Blanc, 'Paper Kite' Sémillon Blanc, & 'Tin Soldier' Sémillon Gris) are exacting and full of character, with a focus on old-vine sites. John's ability to hone a consistent, textured profile across his wines while reflecting the site is marvelous. Thorne & Daughters perfectly tells the story of a once-andfuture South Africa: old vineyards, old-school simplicity, and modern
