"Grapes from the Paardeberg – 90% from a 1973 vineyard and 10% from a 2000 vineyard. 15% whole-bunch fermentation. The nose is very attractive with notes of cherries, plums, floral perfume, herbs, earth and spice while the palate is medium bodied with a dense core of fruit, lemon-like acidity and pleasantly firm tannins."

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"Right up there with my favourite South African Pinotages, this is a wine for lovers of red Burgundy on a budget. Fermented with 15% whole bunches, it's overwhelmingly from a 1973 vineyard, but includes 10% younger material. Tangy, spicy and refreshing, with a lovely sense of energy and bramble, baking spice and wild strawberry flavours. 2023-30." - Tim Atkin, MW

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
