Walker Bay - South Africa

Background

Deep Rooted Wines was founded by Mark Stephens, a young, regenerative viticulturist and winemaker based in Walker Bay, South Africa. With a diverse background in wine, Mark's journey into viticulture began at a regenerative farm in Sonoma during a gap year after high school. Fast forward many years in the industry, and Mark faced health issues due to a high sensitivity to sulfur, and this soon became an annoying occupational hazard. Thankfully, a stint in the Loire Valley showed Mark the missing link between no sulfur and no headache, and this sparked the birth of Deep Rooted Wines. Embracing his home in Walker Bay and other pockets of the Cape South Coast, Mark focuses on cooler, maritime regions, producing bright, energetic, and sulfur-free wines called 'Touch Me' (Verdelho), 'Centre of the Universe' (Sauvignon Blanc), and 'Hinterlands' (Syrah). His wines are additive-free, terroir-focused, and rooted in small-scale viticulture, challenging "natural wine" dogma with a level-headed approach.

Highlights

- 1 Deep Rooted Wines was founded by regenerative viticulturist Mark Stephens in Walker Bay, South Africa.
- 2 The wines (a skinsy Verdelho, an oak-aged Sauvignon Blanc, and a cool-climate Syrah) are all free of added sulfur.
- 3 Mark is part of the new wave 'South Coasters' group that focuses on sustainability & low-intervention winemaking.

Wines

'Centre of the Universe' Fumé Blanc SRP \$24

This is a partial skin-contact, oxidatively-handled Sauvignon Blanc that ferments and ages in old oak. No added sulfur.



'Touch Me' Verdelho SRP \$29

Carbonic maceration is used here to add phenolic grip so that you can FEEL this wine. One thing is for sure... you won't forget the label! No added sulfur.

'Hinterlands' Syrah SRP \$25

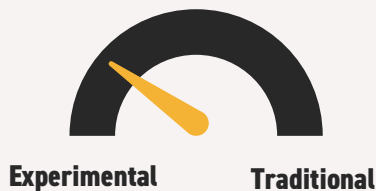
This is a silky Syrah from three Walker Bay vineyards. Aged in used oak. No added sulfur.
