Background

Valentina Passalacqua's Nù Litr is the next evolution of her iconic natural wine line, deeply in her home of Puglia, Known for her liter bottles and elemental labels, Valentina's wines strike a balance between quaffable freshness and vibrant fruit purity. Formerly a lawyer, she launched her winery in 2010 with a mission to craft organic wines that reflect the beauty of her homeland. Nù Litr includes a bianco, orange, rosato, and rosso, all made from certified organic estate vineyards planted on limestone and clay soils. Showcasing native grapes like Primitivo and Negroamaro, the wines offer a lighter, fresher take on a region typically known for bold reds. Grapes are picked early for acidity and lower alcohol, while cellar work remains minimal, with only sulfur added before bottling. These are lively, unpretentious wines meant for sharing, with a slightly softer palate and more focused feel than her previous Calcarius line. Nù Litr is a confident continuation of Valentina's honest, boundarypushing winemaking journey.

Highlights



Valentina Passalacqua makes fresh, low ABV wines from grapes grown on certified organic estate vineyards in Puglia.



The Nù Litr wines (liter bottles of bianco, orange, rosato, and rosso) highlight native grapes like Primitivo and Negroamaro.



With minimal intervention in the cellar and an emphasis on early picking for acidity and low alcohol, Nù Litr continues Valentina's mission of making honest, gathering-friendly wines.

Falanghina, Chardonnay & Fiano in stainless steel with some skin contact. Herbs, citrus, spice.

Nero di Troia and Negroamaro with a quick prefermentation maceration. Dense but bright.

'Nù Litr' Rosso

Nero di Troia, Negroamaro, and Montepulciano aged in cement. Cherries, herbs, stone.
